Windsor Castle

RBWM Advantage Card holders can obtain 50% off admission to the Castle. MOD90 or Defence Discount Scheme (DDS) cardholders can obtain free admission once per year with up to 4 guests at all Royal Collection Trust sites. From Jan to Apr '25 they ran a trial of £1 tickets for people on Universal Credit and other benefits. We're now reviewing feedback from visitors during the trial and hope to bring the scheme back from October 2025.
